REZITRADE - Privacy Policy

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Introduction

This Privacy Policy describes how REZITRADE LLC and its subsidiaries and affiliates ("REZITRADE", "we", "us" or "our") collect, use, store, and share your information when (1) you access and/or use our website and any other digital properties we own, including www.rezitrade.com (Websites"); (2) when you use our products and services ("Services"); (3) when you communicate with us in any manner, including by e-mail or telephone ("Communications"); (4) and when we interact with certain third-parties.

1. What Type Of Information Do We Collect?

Depending on how you interact with our Websites and Services, the nature of our Communications, and how we may interact with certain third-party partners, we may collect the following information from and about you:

- <u>Basic Identifying Information</u>. Information you provide such as your full name, postal address, e-mail address, phone number, account name, username, and other similar identifiers.
- <u>Device Identifier and other Unique Identifiers</u>. Information such as your device identifier, internet
 protocol (IP) address, cookies, beacons, pixel tags, mobile ad identifier, and other unique
 identifiers.
- Internet or Other Network Activity. Information such as your browsing or search history, and other
 information regarding your interactions with our Websites, emails, and advertisements.
- Geolocation Data. Information that permits us to determine your location so that we can determine
 how best to receive our Services.
- <u>Commercial Information</u>. Information such as the nature of the Services you've considered, and related information.
- Business Information. Information such as the name of your business, account, and related information.
- <u>User Content</u>. Information such as your Communications with us and any other content you provide, such as social media profiles, photographs of receipts, images, videos, survey responses, comments, product reviews, testimonials, and other content.
- Audio and Visual Information. Information such as photographs, images, videos, and recordings
 of your voice (such as when we record customer service calls for quality assurance).

 <u>Inferences</u>. Information such as inferences drawn from or created based on the information identified above.

2. How Do We Collect Your Information?

We collect your information in three ways: (1) directly from you when you use our Websites, engage with our Services, or Communicate with us; (2) automatically using online technologies when you engage with our Websites, Services, and Communications; and (3) from our third-party partners.

- <u>Directly from you</u>. We collect information directly from you when you enter your information on our Websites, sign-up for an account with us, access our content, take a survey or a poll or enter a contest, use our Websites and Services, engage in Communications with us, or sign-up to receive emails, text messages, or certain other Communications from us.
- <u>Automatically Using Online Technologies</u>. When you visit our Websites, open or click on emails
 we send you or related Communications, or interact with our advertisements, we or other thirdparties may automatically collect certain information about you using online tracking technologies
 such as cookies, pixels, web beacons, software developer kids, and related technologies. For more
 information, see <u>Cookies and Similar Online Tracking Technologies</u> below.
- <u>From Our Partners</u>. We collect information from our third-party partners, such as brands, data analytics providers, marketing or advertising providers, fraud prevention service providers, and vendors that provide services.

3. Cookies and Related Online Tracking Technologies

We and our third-party partners use cookies, pixels, web beacons, software development kits, and other similar online tracking technologies to gather information about you when you use our Websites, interact with some of our Products, and engage with our Communications. Some of the online tracking technologies are used to maintain the security of our Websites, manage your account, prevent crashes, fix bugs, save your preferences, assist with basic Website functions, advertising, analytics, and other performance functions.

4. How Do We Use Your Information?

We use your information for a variety of purposes, including to:

- <u>Provide our Websites and Services to You</u>. We use your information to provide our Websites and Services to you, including to: (1) create and manage your account when you sign-up to use our Services; (2) facilitate your access and use of our Websites; (3) send you notifications relating to your account and participation in our Services; (4) answer your Communications; and (5) perform other related business functions.
- **Communicate with You**. We use your information to engage in Communications with you, such as to respond to your requests, inquiries, issues, feedback, and to provide customer service.

- Market and Advertise. We use your information for marketing and advertising purposes, including sending marketing, advertising, and promotional communications to you by email, text message, or postal mail. We also use your information to show you advertisements for Services and to administer our sweepstakes and other contests.
- <u>Conduct Analytics and Personalization</u>. We use your information to conduct research and analytics, including to improve our Websites and Services. We also use your information to understand your interaction with our Websites, advertisements, Services, and our Communications with you. We also use your information to personalize your experience, to save you time when you visit our Websites and use our Services, to better understand your needs, and to provide personalized recommendations for our Services.
- <u>Security and Fraud Prevention</u>. We use your information to detect, investigate, prevent, or take
 action regarding possible malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity, including fraudulent
 transactions. We also use your information to enforce our terms and procedures, prevent against
 security incidents, and prevent harm to other users of our Services.
- <u>Legal Obligations</u>. We use your information to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations, to establish and exercise our rights, and to defend against legal claims.
- <u>Business Functions</u>. We use your information to support our core business functions, including to
 maintain records related to business management, loss prevention, collecting amounts owed, and
 identifying and repairing errors or problems in the Websites.

5. How Do We Disclose Your Information?

We may disclose or share your information with affiliated and non-affiliated third-parties, including:

- With your Consent (excluding 10DLC Opt-in Data). We may disclose or share your information with your consent, except for data related to your consent to receive text messages from us. This data will not be shared with third-parties or affiliates for marketing purposes. Your consent may be obtained in writing; online, through "click-through" agreements; when you accept the terms of use on our Websites; orally, either in person or on the phone; or by other means. Please refer to the "Compliance with 10DLC Requirements and Opt-in Data" section below for more information on how we handle your consent to receive messages from us.
- In a Business Transfer. We may disclose or share your information as part of a corporate
 business transaction, such as a merger or acquisition, joint venture, corporate reorganization,
 financing, or sale of company assets, or in the unlikely event of insolvency, bankruptcy, or
 receivership, in which such information could be transferred to third-parties as a business asset
 in the transaction.
- To Non-Affiliated Third-Parties. We may disclose or share your information with certain non-affiliated third-parties to facilitate your access and use of our Websites, our Services, and to provide us with certain business functions, including but not limited to sharing your information with brand partners, internet service providers, advertising networks, data analytics providers, governmental entities, operating systems and platforms, social media networks, and service providers who provide us a service (e.g., customer service, auditing, marketing, debugging to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality on our Websites, and/or protecting against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal

- activity). We ensure that any shared consumer data is protected and securely transmitted to these third-parties or affiliates.
- For Legal Process And Protection. We may disclose or share your information to satisfy any law, regulation, legal process, governmental request, or where we have a good faith belief that access, use, preservation or disclosure of such information is reasonably necessary to: (1) enforce or apply our agreements; (2) protect our interests, property, or safety of others; (3) in connection with claims, disputes, or litigation; and (4) to protect our Websites. Our data sharing practices comply with all applicable federal and state privacy laws, such as the TCPA (Telephone Consumer Protection Act) and the CCPA (California Consumer Privacy Act).

6. Compliance with 10DLC Requirements

We are committed to complying with the 10DLC (10-Digit Long Code) requirements set forth by mobile carriers. These requirements include obtaining your express written consent before sending text messages and ensuring we handle your opt-in data responsibly.

Here's how we handle your 10DLC Opt-in Data:

- We will only use the information you provide to opt-in for our SMS/MMS messaging program (including your phone number) to send you those messages. We will not share this data with any third-party or affiliate for marketing purposes.
- You can always opt-out of receiving text messages from us by replying "STOP" to any message you receive.
- We will retain your opt-in data only for as long as you are subscribed to receive our text messages. Once you opt-out, we will remove your information from our active list within a reasonable timeframe.

In accordance with 10DLC requirements, we will obtain your express consent before sending you any text messages. Your consent to receive messages from our company is specific to us and cannot be transferred to any third-parties. If you wish to receive messages from our affiliated or non-affiliated third-parties, you will need to provide separate consent directly to those parties.

By providing your phone number and opting in to receive text messages from us, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to the terms of this section.

7. How Do We Protect Your Information?

Although no system can guarantee the complete security of your information, we take all commercially reasonable steps to ensure your information is protected in alignment with all applicable laws and regulations, as appropriate to the sensitivity of your information.

8. How Long Do We Keep Your Information?

We keep your information for as long as is necessary in accordance with the purpose for which it was collected, our business needs, and our legal and regulatory obligations. If we dispose of your information, we will do so in a way that is secure and appropriate to nature of the information subject to disposal.

9. <u>Links To Third-Party Sites</u>

Our Websites and Services may contain links to third-party websites and services. Please note that these links are provided for your convenience and information, and the websites and services may operate independently from us and have their own privacy policies or notices, which we strongly suggest you review.

10. Do Not Track

Our Websites may, from time to time, collect information about your online activities, over time and across our different websites. When you use our Websites, third-parties may also collect information about your online activities, over time and across different internet websites, online or cloud computing services, online applications, or mobile applications. Some browsers support a "Do Not Track" feature, which is intended to be a signal to websites that you do not wish to be tracked across different websites you visit. Our Websites do not currently change the way they operate based upon detection of a "Do Not Track" or similar signal.

11. Your Rights

You can stop receiving promotional e-mails at any time by clicking on the "unsubscribe" link at the bottom of any promotional e-mail you receive from us. You can also stop receiving promotional postal mail by sending an e-mail to privacy@rezitrade.com.

12. Children

Our Websites and Products are not intended for children under the age of 13. This includes any links to other websites that we provide for our convenience. We don't knowingly collect the information of children under 13 for any reason.
